

# "Management with EU Law and Sustainable Energy"

## AUTUMN SCHOOL 2012

### Introduction

The **Law & Business in Europe** programme aims to improve core skills for career development within European companies as well as entrepreneurship in the European Union. The programme adopts a strategic approach, combining business and legal expertise integrated by a management design.

The programme, launched as a post-graduate training course in 2005 by the University Institute of European Studies and the Centre for Studies on Federalism, has since been supported by Compagnia di San Paolo.

The Autumn School 2012 is organised in collaboration with the University of Turin Faculty of Law and the Turin Chamber of Commerce, under the auspices of the European Policy Centre and the European Training Foundation.

This programme focuses on the European regulatory framework to be considered when doing business in Europe. EU rights and obligations of business will be considered from a multidisciplinary approach, focusing on legal-economic implications with a look at the political backgrounds.

### Autumn school contents

The Autumn School "Management with EU Law and Sustainable Energy" aims at providing the participants with some instruments and skills to identify, plan and implement business strategies in order to minimize adverse consequences and to increase

positive effects of legal measures.

The training approach is comprised of an introductory two-week online distance learning period (from 29 October to 9 November 2012) and a three-week **face-to-face part (from 12 to 30 November 2012)**, which includes: frontal lectures, practical cases, seminars and workshops.

The Autumn School further comprises executive seminars, characterized by the themes of "Management of Innovation" and "Sustainable Energy".

The Autumn School will focus on:

- ▼ *Business law, firm performance and marketing strategies within the European market*
- ▼ *Strategic tax planning, corporate finance and investment banking in Europe*
- ▼ *Innovation management: strategies-key points; assessment instruments; intellectual property law and European funding opportunities*
- ▼ *Energy efficiency: technological and economic developments*
- ▼ *Sustainable energy and innovation: challenges and strategies*

Thanks to the attendance at the workshops, participants will be assisted in the acquisition of a set of skills to operate successfully in their working environment, through role-plays, management games with innovative companies and drafting projects on sustainable energy.

### Course faculty

The course faculty is composed of prominent experts, professors, law consultants, corporate legal counsels, senior officials from national and European institutions, project consultants and practitioners.

### Participants' profile

The course is designed to appeal to young graduates and professionals from all over the world, dealing with the opportunities of the European institutional framework and the demands of European business.

Tuition fees for the complete programme are set at € 500.00
